Tangier - Morocco

We invite all cruise passengers calling at the Port of Tangier to join our full day excursion to the city of Tangier and the outlying countryside. Lunch will be included.



Morning You will be met at your cruise liner by your guide and driver and taken for a fascinating half day tour of the old town (medina) and souk of Tangier.

The tour will include a visit to the Tangier American Legation Museum which is the only historic landmark of the United States outside of the USA. Displayed inside are a variety of historical items and art exhibits, whilst the museum's library houses a large collection of books, maps, photographs and articles relating to Morocco.

The morning tour of the medina will also include a visit to the fortified Kasbah, one of the city's main attractions. The Kasbah is built on the highest point of the city and has excellent views out over the Straits of Gibraltar and

neighbouring Spain. Within its gates lies a large marble courtyard that leads to the Dar el-Makhzen, a former Sultan's palace built in the 17th century, which today houses the Museum of Moroccan Art.

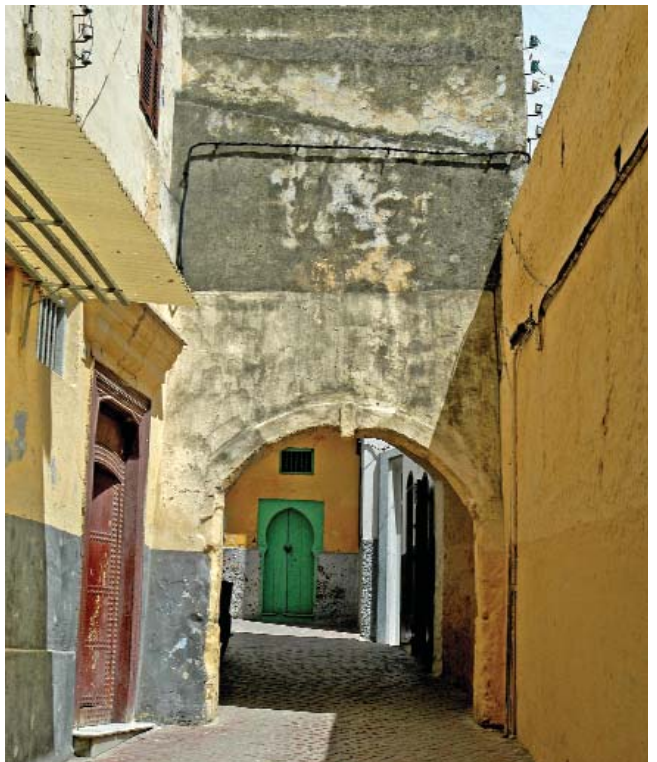
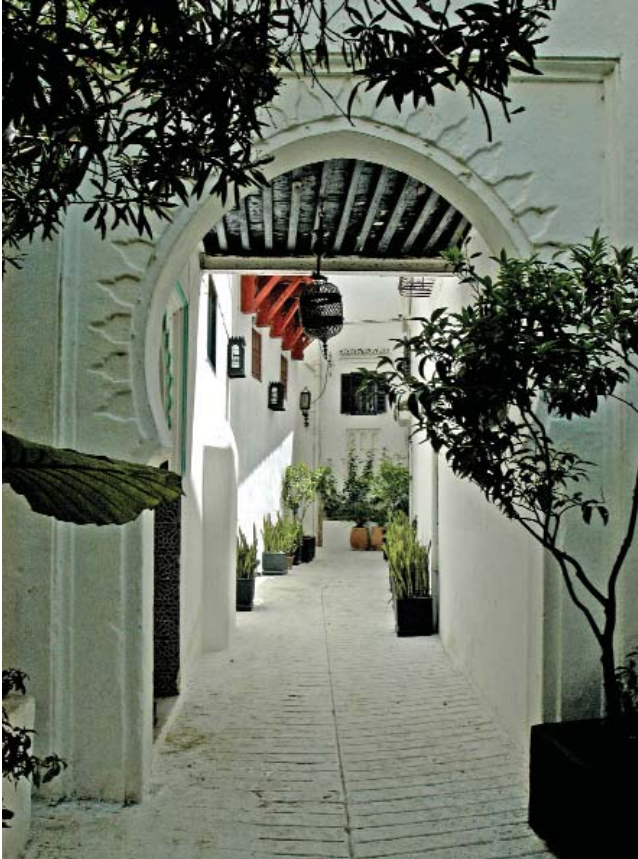


Afternoon

After lunch you will explore the surrounding countryside and stop to visit the Caves of Hercules on the Atlantic. You will also visit the hills of Tangier where the architecture serves as a reminder of the colonial days when the city was ruled by the English, American, French and Spanish.
